How Can I Give? Giving to the Mission and Ministry Endowment Fund is easy, and all gifts, regardless of amount, become a valuable part of Grace Lutheran Church's future, as well as an opportunity for you to make a difference in the life of the congregation for many years to come.



Gifts can be a one-time event or you may choose to give regularly by designating checks or electronic transfers using Realm for the M&M Endowment Fund. No minimum gift or ongoing commitment is required.

Gifts memorializing or honoring someone is a special way to designate funds for the Mission and Ministry Endowment Fund. Please note that gifts memorializing or honoring someone are always combined with other endowment funds and cannot be designated for any special purpose.

A final way to give is through a bequest, devise, or legacy. These require special action on your part to assure that your estate identifies Grace Lutheran Church's Mission and Ministry Endowment Fund as the recipient of your gift. It is important that you discuss your giving plan with your attorney and/or financial advisor to make sure it reflects your wishes and is specified in your will. These types of gifts may include cash funds, real estate, stocks or bonds, mutual funds, or any other asset.

Remember that your gifts, when combined with others received from the Grace family, will build a solid foundation for the future of our congregation. These gifts assure additional financial resources being available for future needs of the church. Please consider prayerfully what you may be able to do to support the future needs of Grace.
